The goal of the ISYS Sport Leadership and Coaching Concentration and Certificate is to advance the coaching profession by engaging sport educators, coaches, and administrators in graduate level study. The coursework focuses on maximizing the total development of the individual participant physically, psychologically, and socially. Students who complete these courses gain cutting-edge knowledge about how to simultaneously develop great athletes and great people.

Courses

Physical Bases of Coaching

Learn principles of anatomy, physiology, sports medicine, and biomechanics to enhance your coaching.

Psychosocial Bases of Coaching

Study the sociological, psychological, developmental, and instructional principles that will enhance your athletes' development.

Sport Law for Coaches & Administrators

Be prepared to handle the responsibilities of leading a team or program and avoid the pitfalls that lead to safety and legal issues.

Promoting Positive Youth Development

Become a transformational leader by exploring ways to facilitate the development of life skills and character in your athletes.

What is Involved?

These courses represent a concentration in the online M.A. degree offered by the College of Education (www.education.msu.edu/onlineedu). Three of the four courses are needed to complete the concentration.

For those not seeking a graduate degree, the courses can be taken as a lifelong student with three courses needed to receive a graduate certificate in coaching education.

Courses are normally offered once a year on a rotating, semester basis. It is possible to complete the online certificate in a calendar year.
